What is Praise?

- Praise is the verbal and heartfelt expression of God's nature, works, and worth.
- It involves celebrating His greatness, declaring His goodness, and responding in awe.

Praise vs. Worship

- Praise = public declaration; often joyful, energetic.
- Worship = deeper reverence; often personal, intimate.
- Both are essential, but we are to use our praise as proclamation of our faith—our allegiance to Jesus.

Praise is Constant, NOT Occasional
